Please pay close attention to the following details for Concert for the Causes:

- The event will be **Saturday, May 7, 2022 with gates opening at 5:00pm at the Kern County Raceway** featuring **Easton Corbin** and Joe and Martina, Joe Peters, The Rivals Band.
- Vendors may set up starting at **10:00 AM** and must be completed by 5:30pm.
- Vendors must bring their own table, pop-ups (if shade is desired), extension cords, generators (quiet), WiFi, and any other necessary materials/equipment. No items will be supplied by the event.
- Food Vendors must provide a copy of their food permit(s)
- Vendors must provide a copy of their insurance naming Concert for the Causes **AND** Kern County Raceway Park as an additional insured.
- All items must be cleaned up the night of the event.
- Cost to be a vendor is \$500 and is non-refundable. Must submit payment to secure space.

General Rules:

- No alcohol or smoking (including vaporizers and chewing tobacco) allowed.
- No pets allowed (with the exception of service animals).

Concert for the Causes benefiting League of Dreams (LOD), MARE Riding Center (MARE), Wounded Heroes Fund (WHF), and Kern County Raceway Park (KCRP). The organizations are 501c3 non-profit organizations and as such requires that users insure against liability arising from their use.
